1) The workers will not have been constructing the building for a year.

Pos: Will the workers have been constructing the building for a year?

2) I will not have been studying English for six months.

Pos: Will I have been studying English for six months?

3) You will not have been working on the project for several hours.

Pos: Will you have been working on the project for several hours?

4) He will not have been practicing the piano all day.

Pos: Will he have been practicing the piano all day?

5) She will not have been studying for the exam since morning.

Pos: Will she have been studying for the exam since morning?

6) We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

Pos: Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

7) They will not have been playing soccer for the entire afternoon.

Pos: Will they have been playing soccer for the entire afternoon?

8) John will not have been working as a chef for ten years.

Pos: Will John have been working as a chef for ten years?

9) Sarah will not have been traveling around the world for months.

Pos: Will Sarah have been traveling around the world for months?

10) I will not have been working on this project for six months.

Pos: Will I have been working on this project for six months?
