**1)** Had it been raining heavily all day long?

**Neg:** It had not been raining heavily all day long.

---

**2)** Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

**Neg:** He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

---

**3)** Had the children been playing outside for hours?

**Neg:** The children had not been playing outside for hours.

---

**4)** Had she been waiting at the airport for three hours?

**Neg:** She had not been waiting at the airport for three hours.

---

**5)** Have I been reading a book since morning?

**Neg:** I have not been reading a book since morning.

---

**6)** Had he been playing video games since morning?

**Neg:** He had not been playing video games since morning.

---

**7)** Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

**Neg:** It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

---

**8)** Will I have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive?

**Neg:** I will not have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

---

**9)** Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

**Neg:** I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

**10)** Had Sarah been working on her art project all day?

**Neg:** Sarah had not been working on her art project all day.
