1) It had not been raining heavily all day long.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all day long?

2) He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

Que: Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

3) The children had not been playing outside for hours.

Que: Had the children been playing outside for hours?

4) She had not been waiting at the airport for three hours.

Que: Had she been waiting at the airport for three hours?

5) I have not been reading a book since morning.

Que: Have I been reading a book since morning?

6) He had not been playing video games since morning.

Que: Had he been playing video games since morning?

7) It has not been raining since yesterday afternoon.

Que: Has it been raining since yesterday afternoon?

8) I will not have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive.

Que: Will I have been working on this project for three hours by the time you arrive?

9) I had not been studying for the exam for hours.

Que: Had I been studying for the exam for hours?

10) Sarah had not been working on her art project all day.

Que: Had Sarah been working on her art project all day?
