1) John has been studying for the exam all week.

Neg: John has not been studying for the exam all week.

Que: Has John been studying for the exam all week?

2) They have completed the course.

Neg: They have not completed the course.

Que: Have they completed the course?

3) I have met interesting people.

Neg: I have not met interesting people.

Que: Have I met interesting people?

4) They are rehearsing for a play.

Neg: They are not rehearsing for a play.

Que: Are they rehearsing for a play?

5) Mary has been playing the piano for years.

Neg: Mary has not been playing the piano for years.

Que: Has Mary been playing the piano for years?
