1) Has John been studying for the exam all week?

Pos: John has been studying for the exam all week.

Neg: John has not been studying for the exam all week.

2) Have they completed the course?

Pos: They have completed the course.

Neg: They have not completed the course.

3) Have I met interesting people?

Pos: I have met interesting people.

Neg: I have not met interesting people.

4) Are they rehearsing for a play?

Pos: They are rehearsing for a play.

Neg: They are not rehearsing for a play.

5) Has Mary been playing the piano for years?

Pos: Mary has been playing the piano for years.

Neg: Mary has not been playing the piano for years.
