Pos: Will you be going to the concert next Friday?

5) He will not be taking a cooking class next month.

Pos: Will he be taking a cooking class next month?

6) She will not be volunteering at the local shelter this weekend.

Pos: Will she be volunteering at the local shelter this weekend?

7) We will not be preparing for the party tomorrow.

Pos: Will we be preparing for the party tomorrow?

8) They will not be hiking in the mountains next week.

Pos: Will they be hiking in the mountains next week?

9) It will not be raining heavily tonight.

Pos: Will it be raining heavily tonight?

10) John will not be attending a business conference next month.

Pos: Will John be attending a business conference next month?
