

Exercise -Future Perfect Continuous Tense (Key)

1) John had not been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

Pos: John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

Que: Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?

2) Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.

Pos: Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.

Que: Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?

3) I had not been studying English for three months.

Pos: I had been studying English for three months.

Que: Had I been studying English for three months?

4) You had not been working on the project all day.

Pos: You had been working on the project all day.

Que: Had you been working on the project all day?

5) He had not been playing the guitar for two hours.

Pos: He had been playing the guitar for two hours.

Que: Had he been playing the guitar for two hours?
