

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Have we been traveling for weeks?

Pos: We have been traveling for weeks.

Neg: We have not been traveling for weeks.

2) Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

Pos: Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

Neg: Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

3) Had he been studying Spanish for months?

Pos: He had been studying Spanish for months.

Neg: He had not been studying Spanish for months.

4) Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

Pos: We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

5) Had it been raining since yesterday?

Pos: It had been raining since yesterday.

Neg: It had not been raining since yesterday.

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
