

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) We have not been traveling for weeks.

Pos: We have been traveling for weeks.

Que: Have we been traveling for weeks?

2) Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

Pos: Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

Que: Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

3) He had not been studying Spanish for months.

Pos: He had been studying Spanish for months.

Que: Had he been studying Spanish for months?

4) We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

Pos: We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

5) It had not been raining since yesterday.

Pos: It had been raining since yesterday.

Que: Had it been raining since yesterday?
