**1)** We have not been traveling for weeks.

**Pos:** We have been traveling for weeks.

**Que:** Have we been traveling for weeks?

**2)** Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

**Pos:** Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

---

**Que:** Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

---

**3)** He had not been studying Spanish for months.

**Pos:** He had been studying Spanish for months.

---

**Que:** Had he been studying Spanish for months?

---

**4)** We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

**Pos:** We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

---

**Que:** Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

---

**5)** It had not been raining since yesterday.

**Pos:** It had been raining since yesterday.

---

**Que:** Had it been raining since yesterday?
