

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: We have been traveling for weeks.

Neg: We have not been traveling for weeks.

Que: Have we been traveling for weeks?

2) Pos: Mary has been learning to play the piano for years.

Neg: Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

Que: Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

3) Pos: He had been studying Spanish for months.

Neg: He had not been studying Spanish for months.

Que: Had he been studying Spanish for months?

4) Pos: We will have been waiting in line for two hours.

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

Que: Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

5) Pos: It had been raining since yesterday.

Neg: It had not been raining since yesterday.

Que: Had it been raining since yesterday?
