Que: Did you visit the library last week?

8) They didn't go for a hike in the mountains yesterday.

Que: Did they go for a hike in the mountains yesterday?

9) They don't volunteer at the local shelter.

Que: Do they volunteer at the local shelter?

10) We don't go on vacation every summer.

Que: Do we go on vacation every summer?
