1) Will he have painted the entire room?

Neg: He will not have painted the entire room.

2) Had she finished her book?

Neg: She had not finished her book.

3) Will I have achieved my targets?

Neg: I will not have achieved my targets.

4) Will he have repaired the car?

Neg: He will not have repaired the car.

5) Had they attended the meeting?

Neg: They had not attended the meeting.

6) Will I have mastered the skill?

Neg: I will not have mastered the skill.

7) Will she have published her book?

Neg: She will not have published her book.

8) Will I have completed my responsibilities?

Neg: I will not have completed my responsibilities.

9) Has it been a long day?

Neg: It has not been a long day.

10) Will it have been a challenging task?

Neg: It will not have been a challenging task.
