Pos: She had been writing her novel since morning.

Que: Had she been writing her novel since morning?

2) We had not been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Pos: We had been waiting for the train for half an hour.

Que: Had we been waiting for the train for half an hour?

3) They had not been practicing their dance routine for weeks.

Pos: They had been practicing their dance routine for weeks.

Que: Had they been practicing their dance routine for weeks?

4) It had not been raining heavily all afternoon.

Pos: It had been raining heavily all afternoon.

Que: Had it been raining heavily all afternoon?

5) John had not been studying for the exam since morning.

Pos: John had been studying for the exam since morning.

Que: Had John been studying for the exam since morning?
