1) Have you been working late every night this week?

Pos: You have been working late every night this week.

Neg: You have not been working late every night this week.

2) Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.

Neg: She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

Neg: The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

4) Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

Pos: They had been playing football for the entire afternoon.

Neg: They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.

Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?

Pos: The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.

Neg: The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.
