**1)** Have you been working late every night this week?

**Pos:** You have been working late every night this week.

**Neg:** You have not been working late every night this week.

**2)** Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

**Pos:** She had been practicing the piano for hours.

**Neg:** She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

**3)** Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining?

**Pos:** The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

---

**Neg:** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started raining.

---

**4)** Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

**Pos:** They had been playing football for the entire afternoon.

---

**Neg:** They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.

---

**5)** Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain?

**Pos:** The children had been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.

---

**Neg:** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon before it started to rain.
