1) Will you be studying for the exam?

Neg: You will not be studying for the exam.

2) Will they be traveling to Asia next year?

Neg: They will not be traveling to Asia next year.

3) Was it raining heavily?

Neg: It was not raining heavily.

4) Is the cat purring softly?

Neg: The cat is not purring softly.

5) Will John be working on a project this weekend?

Neg: John will not be working on a project this weekend.

6) Are they laughing loudly?

Neg: They are not laughing loudly.

7) Will the team be practicing for the game this evening?

Neg: The team will not be practicing for the game this evening.

8) Will I be studying for the exam tomorrow?

Neg: I will not be studying for the exam tomorrow.

9) Are you playing the piano?

Neg: You are not playing the piano.

10) Is the sun shining brightly?

Neg: The sun is not shining brightly.
