Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Will you have traveled to your dream destination?

Neg: You will not have traveled to your dream destination.

2) Have I met interesting people?

Neg: I have not met interesting people.

3) Will we have reached our fundraising target?

Neg: We will not have reached our fundraising target.

4) Had you visited London last year?

Neg: You had not visited London last year.

5) Will she have achieved financial independence?

Neg: She will not have achieved financial independence.

6) Had they won the game?

Neg: They had not won the game.

7) Had they attended the meeting?

Neg: They had not attended the meeting.

8) Will they have accomplished their mission?

Neg: They will not have accomplished their mission.

9) Will they have finished the renovation?

Neg: They will not have finished the renovation.

10) Has it been a successful event?

Neg: It has not been a successful event.
