

Example Sentences of continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: It will be getting dark soon.

Neg: It will not be getting dark soon.

Que: Will it be getting dark soon?

2) Pos: We will be celebrating our anniversary next Saturday.

Neg: We will not be celebrating our anniversary next Saturday.

Que: Will we be celebrating our anniversary next Saturday?

3) Pos: The team will be practicing for the game this evening.

Neg: The team will not be practicing for the game this evening.

Que: Will the team be practicing for the game this evening?

4) Pos: She will be working on her project all day.

Neg: She will not be working on her project all day.

Que: Will she be working on her project all day?

5) Pos: He will be playing basketball at the gym later.

Neg: He will not be playing basketball at the gym later.

Que: Will he be playing basketball at the gym later?
