



Perfect continuous Form of Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) Will you have been working on the project for several hours?

Neg: You will not have been working on the project for several hours.

2) Has it been raining since this morning?

Neg: It has not been raining since this morning.

3) Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.

4) Had he been playing video games all day?

Neg: He had not been playing video games all day.

5) Will we have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens?

Neg: We will not have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens.

6) Had they been studying for the exam all week?

Neg: They had not been studying for the exam all week.

7) Had I been working on this project for the past week?

Neg: I had not been working on this project for the past week.

8) Will Sarah have been working on her novel for months?

Neg: Sarah will not have been working on her novel for months.

9) Had it been raining heavily all day long?

Neg: It had not been raining heavily all day long.

10) Have they been learning to play the guitar for weeks?

Neg: They have not been learning to play the guitar for weeks.
