2) I will have lived in this city for five years.

Neg: I will not have lived in this city for five years.

Que: Will I have lived in this city for five years?

3) You will have saved enough money for vacation.

Neg: You will not have saved enough money for vacation.

Que: Will you have saved enough money for vacation?

4) He will have received the award.

Neg: He will not have received the award.

Que: Will he have received the award?

5) She will have written a best-selling book.

Neg: She will not have written a best-selling book.

Que: Will she have written a best-selling book?
