1) Does he wear a red hat?

Neg: He doesn't wear a red hat.

2) Has John been studying Spanish for a month?

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for a month.

3) Have they eaten dinner?

Neg: They have not eaten dinner.

4) Do you watch the sunset at the beach?

Neg: We don't watch the sunset at the beach.

5) Has John been studying Spanish for months?

Neg: John has not been studying Spanish for months.

6) Is the train leaving soon?

Neg: The train is not leaving soon.

7) Have I met my goals?

Neg: I have not met my goals.

8) Does she paint beautiful pictures?

Neg: She doesn't paint beautiful pictures.

9) Do you watch movies on weekends?

Neg: You don't watch movies on weekends.

10) Have the workers been building the house for months?

Neg: The workers have not been building the house for months.
