**1)** Will it have been raining for days by the time we arrive?

**Neg:** It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

---

**2)** Have we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?

**Neg:** We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

---

**3)** Has she been baking a cake for the party?

**Neg:** She has not been baking a cake for the party.

---

**4)** Had we been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination?

**Neg:** We had not been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination.

---

**5)** Have you been working hard all day?

**Neg:** You have not been working hard all day.

---

**6)** Had he been playing the guitar since the morning?

**Neg:** He had not been playing the guitar since the morning.

---

**7)** Will we have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens?

**Neg:** We will not have been waiting in line for hours before the store opens.

---

**8)** Have you been working on the project all day?

**Neg:** You have not been working on the project all day.

---

**9)** Had he been working in the garden since early morning?

**Neg:** He had not been working in the garden since early morning.

**10)** Will we have been waiting in line for two hours?

**Neg:** We will not have been waiting in line for two hours.
