Neg: We have not been waiting in line for the concert for hours. 3) Has she been baking a cake for the party? Neg: She has not been baking a cake for the party. Had we been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination? 4) Neg: We had not been traveling for hours before we arrived at our destination. 5) Have you been working hard all day?
