

## Exercise Key-Perfect Continuous Form of Tense

**1)** Will John have been studying for the exam all night?

**Pos:** John will have been studying for the exam all night.

---

**Neg:** John will not have been studying for the exam all night.

---

**2)** Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

**Pos:** We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

---

**Neg:** We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

---

**3)** Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

**Pos:** John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

---

**Neg:** John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

---

**4)** Had the children been playing outside for hours?

**Pos:** The children had been playing outside for hours.

---

**Neg:** The children had not been playing outside for hours.

---

**5)** Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early morning?

**Pos:** They had been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

---

**Neg:** They had not been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.
