

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) John will not have been studying for the exam all night.

Pos: John will have been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Will John have been studying for the exam all night?

2) We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

3) John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

Pos: John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

Que: Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

4) The children had not been playing outside for hours.

Pos: The children had been playing outside for hours.

Que: Had the children been playing outside for hours?

5) They had not been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

Pos: They had been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

Que: Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early morning?
