

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: John will have been studying for the exam all night.

Neg: John will not have been studying for the exam all night.

Que: Will John have been studying for the exam all night?

2) Pos: We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Neg: We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

3) Pos: John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

Neg: John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

Que: Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

4) Pos: The children had been playing outside for hours.

Neg: The children had not been playing outside for hours.

Que: Had the children been playing outside for hours?

5) Pos: They had been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

Neg: They had not been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.

Que: Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early morning?
