Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Will Sarah be cooking dinner for the family?

Neg: Sarah will not be cooking dinner for the family.

2) Will we be watching a movie tonight?

Neg: We will not be watching a movie tonight.

3) Was it getting brighter outside?

Neg: It was not getting brighter outside.

4) Will we be attending the concert this weekend?

Neg: We will not be attending the concert this weekend.

5) Is it snowing lightly?

Neg: It is not snowing lightly.

6) Was John writing an email?

Neg: John was not writing an email.

7) Is she talking on the phone?

Neg: She is not talking on the phone.

8) Will I be studying for my exams tomorrow?

Neg: I will not be studying for my exams tomorrow.

9) Is the dog wagging its tail?

Neg: The dog is not wagging its tail.

10) Was the baby crying?

Neg: The baby was not crying.
