

Exercise Key-Continous Form of Tense

1) John will be studying in the library.

Neg: John will not be studying in the library.

Que: Will John be studying in the library?

2) John was writing an email.

Neg: John was not writing an email.

Que: Was John writing an email?

3) The train is leaving soon.

Neg: The train is not leaving soon.

Que: Is the train leaving soon?

4) Sarah will be attending a party.

Neg: Sarah will not be attending a party.

Que: Will Sarah be attending a party?

5) I will be reading a book.

Neg: I will not be reading a book.

Que: Will I be reading a book?
