1) Have they been practicing their lines for weeks?

Pos: They have been practicing their lines for weeks.

2) Have we been waiting in line for the concert for hours?

Pos: We have been waiting in line for the concert for hours.

3) Had it been raining heavily all day?

Pos: It had been raining heavily all day.

4) Had the workers been building the house for months before it was completed?

Pos: The workers had been building the house for months before it was completed.

5) Had John been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country?

Pos: John had been studying English for months before he moved to an English-speaking country.

6) Had John been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it?

Pos: John had been working on his novel for months before he finally completed it.

7) Have I been reading a book for the past hour?

Pos: I have been reading a book for the past hour.

8) Had we been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside?

Pos: We had been living in the city for a decade before we moved to the countryside.

9) Had you been studying English for a long time before the exam?

Pos: You had been studying English for a long time before the exam.

10) Will she have been writing the book for several years?

Pos: She will have been writing the book for several years.
