Que: Will we have built our dream house?

4) They will have planted a hundred trees.

Neg: They will not have planted a hundred trees.

Que: Will they have planted a hundred trees?

5) It will have been a successful collaboration.

Neg: It will not have been a successful collaboration.

Que: Will it have been a successful collaboration?
