3) You will not have been working on the project all day.

Pos: You will have been working on the project all day.

Que: Will you have been working on the project all day?

4) He will not have been practicing the piano for a month.

Pos: He will have been practicing the piano for a month.

Que: Will he have been practicing the piano for a month?

5) She will not have been writing the book for several years.

Pos: She will have been writing the book for several years.

Que: Will she have been writing the book for several years?
