

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Have I been reading this book for hours?

Pos: I have been reading this book for hours.

Neq: I have not been reading this book for hours.

2) Will he have been practicing the piano all day?

Pos: He will have been practicing the piano all day.

Neg: He will not have been practicing the piano all day.

3) Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

Pos: They had been playing football for the entire afternoon.

Neg: They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.

4) Had we been driving for hours before we reached our destination?

Pos: We had been driving for hours before we reached our destination.

Neg: We had not been driving for hours before we reached our destination.

5) Had they been studying for the test all week?

Pos: They had been studying for the test all week.

Neg: They had not been studying for the test all week.
