1) I have not been reading this book for hours.

Pos: I have been reading this book for hours.

Que: Have I been reading this book for hours?

2) He will not have been practicing the piano all day.

Pos: He will have been practicing the piano all day.

Que: Will he have been practicing the piano all day?

3) They had not been playing football for the entire afternoon.

Pos: They had been playing football for the entire afternoon.

Que: Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

4) We had not been driving for hours before we reached our destination.

Pos: We had been driving for hours before we reached our destination.

Que: Had we been driving for hours before we reached our destination?

5) They had not been studying for the test all week.

Pos: They had been studying for the test all week.

Que: Had they been studying for the test all week?
