

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: I have been reading this book for hours.

Neg: I have not been reading this book for hours.

Que: Have I been reading this book for hours?

2) Pos: He will have been practicing the piano all day.

Neg: He will not have been practicing the piano all day.

Que: Will he have been practicing the piano all day?

3) Pos: They had been playing football for the entire

afternoon.

Neg: They had not been playing football for the entire

afternoon.

Que: Had they been playing football for the entire afternoon?

4) Pos: We had been driving for hours before we reached our

destination.

Neg: We had not been driving for hours before we reached our

destination.

Que: Had we been driving for hours before we reached our

destination?

5) Pos: They had been studying for the test all week.

Neg: They had not been studying for the test all week.

Que: Had they been studying for the test all week?
