Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Has she won the competition?

Neg: She has not won the competition.

2) Has he written a book?

Neg: He has not written a book.

3) Has it started raining?

Neg: It has not started raining.

4) Had I finished my work?

Neg: I had not finished my work.

5) Will he have repaired the car?

Neg: He will not have repaired the car.

6) Will it have been a productive day?

Neg: It will not have been a productive day.

7) Has it become quiet?

Neg: It has not become quiet.

8) Has it become dark?

Neg: It has not become dark.

9) Have I met interesting people?

Neg: I have not met interesting people.

10) Had he written a book?

Neg: He had not written a book.
