



Perfect continuous Form of Tense **Write Negative Sentences (Key)**

1) Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

Neg: *It has not been snowing heavily since morning.*

2) Has Mary been playing tennis for years?

Neg: *Mary has not been playing tennis for years.*

3) Have the students been studying for the test all day?

Neg: *The students have not been studying for the test all day.*

4) Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early morning?

Neg: *They had not been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.*

5) Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?

Neg: *Sarah had not been working out at the gym for an hour.*

6) Had John been studying for the exam all night?

Neg: *John had not been studying for the exam all night.*

7) Have they been discussing the project all day?

Neg: *They have not been discussing the project all day.*

8) Has she been working on her computer all day?

Neg: *She has not been working on her computer all day.*

9) Has it been raining since this morning?

Neg: *It has not been raining since this morning.*

10) Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

Neg: *We had not been traveling for days before reaching our destination.*
