1) Has it been snowing heavily since morning?

Pos: *It has been snowing heavily since morning.*

2) Has Mary been playing tennis for years?

Pos: *Mary has been playing tennis for years.*

3) Have the students been studying for the test all day?

Pos: *The students have been studying for the test all day.*

4) Had they been waiting in line for the concert since early morning?

Pos: *They had been waiting in line for the concert since early morning.*

5) Had Sarah been working out at the gym for an hour?

Pos: *Sarah had been working out at the gym for an hour.*

6) Had John been studying for the exam all night?

Pos: *John had been studying for the exam all night.*

7) Have they been discussing the project all day?

Pos: *They have been discussing the project all day.*

8) Has she been working on her computer all day?

Pos: *She has been working on her computer all day.*

9) Has it been raining since this morning?

Pos: *It has been raining since this morning.*

10) Had we been traveling for days before reaching our destination?

Pos: *We had been traveling for days before reaching our destination.*
