1) We will not have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Pos: We will have been waiting for the bus for an hour.

Que: Will we have been waiting for the bus for an hour?

2) They will not have been playing soccer since morning.

Pos: They will have been playing soccer since morning.

Que: Will they have been playing soccer since morning?

3) It will not have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

Pos: It will have been raining for days by the time we arrive.

Que: Will it have been raining for days by the time we arrive?

4) John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

Pos: John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

Que: Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?

5) Sarah will not have been studying abroad for six months.

Pos: Sarah will have been studying abroad for six months.

Que: Will Sarah have been studying abroad for six months?
