1) He had not been playing basketball since morning.

Pos: He had been playing basketball since morning.

Que: Had he been playing basketball since morning?

2) I had not been studying English for three months.

Pos: I had been studying English for three months.

Que: Had I been studying English for three months?

3) You had not been working on the project all day.

Pos: You had been working on the project all day.

Que: Had you been working on the project all day?

4) She had not been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Pos: She had been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Que: Had she been cooking dinner for the party all evening?

5) She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.

Que: Had she been practicing the piano for hours?

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
