

Example Sentences of Perfect continuous Form of Tense

1) Pos: He had been playing basketball since morning.

Neg: He had not been playing basketball since morning.

Que: Had he been playing basketball since morning?

2) Pos: I had been studying English for three months.

Neg: I had not been studying English for three months.

Que: Had I been studying English for three months?

3) Pos: You had been working on the project all day.

Neg: You had not been working on the project all day.

Que: Had you been working on the project all day?

4) Pos: She had been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Neg: She had not been cooking dinner for the party all evening.

Que: Had she been cooking dinner for the party all evening?

5) Pos: She had been practicing the piano for hours.

Neg: She had not been practicing the piano for hours.

Que: Had she been practicing the piano for hours?
