Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Had Sarah finished her book before starting a new one?

Neg: Sarah had not finished her book before starting a new one.

2) Will we have celebrated the anniversary?

Neg: We will not have celebrated the anniversary.

3) Have I finished my lunch?

Neg: I have not finished my lunch.

4) Has she finished her workout?

Neg: She has not finished her workout.

5) Had she written a letter to her friend?

Neg: She had not written a letter to her friend.

6) Had he eaten lunch before the meeting?

Neg: He had not eaten lunch before the meeting.

7) Will I have graduated from college?

Neg: I will not have graduated from college.

8) Had you already seen that movie before?

Neg: You had not already seen that movie before.

9) Have they seen a concert?

Neg: They have not seen a concert.

10) Had she met him before?

Neg: She had not met him before.
