

Perfect continuous Form of Tense Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1)	Had you been studying Spanish for months before your trip to Spain?
Neg:	You had not been studying Spanish for months before your trip to Spain.
2)	Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?
Neg:	Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.
3)	Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?
Neg:	Sarah has not been working on her art project all day.
4)	Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?
Neg:	Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.
5)	Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon?
Neg:	The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon.
6)	Had the students been studying English grammar lately?
Neg:	The students had not been studying English grammar lately.
7)	Had you been studying for the exam all night?
Neg:	You had not been studying for the exam all night.
8)	Had he been playing video games since morning?
Neg:	He had not been playing video games since morning.
9)	Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?
Neg:	We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.
10)	Had we been traveling around Europe for weeks?
Neg:	We had not been traveling around Europe for weeks.
