**1)** Had you been studying Spanish for months before your trip to Spain?

**Neg:** You had not been studying Spanish for months before your trip to Spain.

**2)** Had Sarah been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance?

**Neg:** Sarah had not been practicing the piano for years before her concert performance.

---

**3)** Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?

**Neg:** Sarah has not been working on her art project all day.

---

**4)** Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?

**Neg:** Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

---

**5)** Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon?

**Neg:** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon.

---

**6)** Had the students been studying English grammar lately?

**Neg:** The students had not been studying English grammar lately.

---

**7)** Had you been studying for the exam all night?

**Neg:** You had not been studying for the exam all night.

---

**8)** Had he been playing video games since morning?

**Neg:** He had not been playing video games since morning.

---

**9)** Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?

**Neg:** We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

**10)** Had we been traveling around Europe for weeks?

**Neg:** We had not been traveling around Europe for weeks.
