**3)** Sarah has not been working on her art project all day.

**Que:** *Has Sarah been working on her art project all day?*

**4)** Mary has not been learning to play the piano for years.

**Que:** *Has Mary been learning to play the piano for years?*

**5)** The children had not been playing in the park all afternoon.

**Que:** *Had the children been playing in the park all afternoon?*

**6)** The students had not been studying English grammar lately.

**Que:** *Had the students been studying English grammar lately?*

**7)** You had not been studying for the exam all night.

**Que:** *Had you been studying for the exam all night?*

**8)** He had not been playing video games since morning.

**Que:** *Had he been playing video games since morning?*

**9)** We have not been waiting for the bus for half an hour.

**Que:** *Have we been waiting for the bus for half an hour?*

**Que:** *Had we been traveling around Europe for weeks?*
