Neg: John will not be playing basketball this evening.

4) Will I be studying for the exam tomorrow?

Neg: I will not be studying for the exam tomorrow.

5) Will you be traveling to Europe next month?

Neg: You will not be traveling to Europe next month.

6) Will he be playing tennis in the afternoon?

Neg: He will not be playing tennis in the afternoon.

7) Will we be attending the concert this weekend?

Neg: We will not be attending the concert this weekend.

8) Will they be having dinner at the restaurant tonight?

Neg: They will not be having dinner at the restaurant tonight.

9) Will it be raining heavily tomorrow?

Neg: It will not be raining heavily tomorrow.

10) Will the team be practicing for the match on Friday?

Neg: The team will not be practicing for the match on Friday.
