**Pos:** I have been working on this project all week.

**Que:** Have I been working on this project all week?

**Pos:** The students have been preparing for the presentation.

**Que:** Have the students been preparing for the presentation?

**4)** We had not been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

**Pos:** We had been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

---

**Que:** Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?

---

**5)** John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

**Pos:** John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

---

**Que:** Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?
