

Exercise Key-Perfect Continous Form of Tense

1) Sarah had not been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Pos: Sarah had been cooking dinner for the family for hours.

Que: Had Sarah been cooking dinner for the family for hours?

2) I have not been working on this project all week.

Pos: I have been working on this project all week.

Que: Have I been working on this project all week?

3) The students have not been preparing for the presentation.

Pos: The students have been preparing for the presentation.

Que: Have the students been preparing for the presentation?

4) We had not been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

Pos: We had been traveling for hours before reaching the destination.

Que: Had we been traveling for hours before reaching the destination?

5) John will not have been working as a teacher for five years.

Pos: John will have been working as a teacher for five years.

Que: Will John have been working as a teacher for five years?
