Neg: We don't play board games on weekends.

2) She will learn to play the piano.

Neg: She will not learn to play the piano.

3) You met your friend at the café yesterday.

Neg: You didn't meet your friend at the café yesterday.

4) The cat slept on the bed all day.

Neg: The cat didn't sleep on the bed all day.

5) The cat will catch the bird.

Neg: The cat will not catch the bird.

6) She talks to her friends on the phone.

Neg: She doesn't talk to her friends on the phone.

7) It will rain later today.

Neg: It will not rain later today.

8) He bought a new laptop last week.

Neg: He didn't buy a new laptop last week.

9) You like chocolate ice cream.

Neg: You don't like chocolate ice cream.

10) They played soccer in the park yesterday.

Neg: They didn't play soccer in the park yesterday.
