Write Negative Sentences (Key)

1) Had they already eaten dinner?

Neg: They had not already eaten dinner.

2) Will he have bought a new house?

Neg: He will not have bought a new house.

3) Will it have been a memorable journey?

Neg: It will not have been a memorable journey.

4) Will they have planted a hundred trees?

Neg: They will not have planted a hundred trees.

5) Will you have finished your homework?

Neg: You will not have finished your homework.

6) Will she have published her book?

Neg: She will not have published her book.

7) Had she written a poem for her mother?

Neg: She had not written a poem for her mother.

8) Has the team won the championship?

Neg: The team has not won the championship.

9) Will it have been a fulfilling career?

Neg: It will not have been a fulfilling career.

10) Has he completed the task?

Neg: He has not completed the task.
